

POST-OP INSTRUCTIONS FOR BLEPHAROPLASTY (Eyelid Surgery)

- 1. Always wash hands with antibacterial soap before changing your ice compress or touching your incisions.
- 2. **DO NOT** bend, strain, or lift anything greater than a milk carton.
- 3. Sleep with your head elevated using 3-4 pillows.
- 4. Apply ophthalmic antibiotic ointment twice a day.
- 5. You may use saline eye drops for comfort as needed.
- 6. Swelling and bruising is expected and normal.
- 7. Ice compress should be used for 48 hours and then for comfort after that.
- 8. Notify your doctor at **601.939.9999** or **1.866.939.4999** if a temperature develops of 101 degrees lasting more than 24 hours or if there are any signs of infection.
- 9. If you are unable to reach a physician and immediate attention is needed, please go to the nearest emergency room.
