

POST- OP INSTRUCTIONS AFTER A SEPTO/RHINOPLASTY (Nose Surgery)

- 1. Sleep with your head elevated using 3-4 pillow or sleep in a recliner.
- 2. **DO NOT** stoop over, strain or lift anything greater than a milk carton, do not blow your nose. If you have to sneeze, do so with your mouth open.
- 3. Change the drip pad under your nose as needed. You should expect some bloody drainage.
- 4. Keep nasal splint dry and intact.
- 5. If you have internal splints, you will need to breathe with your mouth open. These will be removed at your post op clinic appointment.
- 6. You can drive as long as you are **NOT** taking any prescription pain medication.
- 7. You may discontinue your prescription pain medication and use Ibuprofen or Tylenol as tolerated.
- 8. You may use over the counter saline nose pray to help gently clean the nostrils.
- 9. Notify your Doctor at **601.939.9999** or **1.866.939.4999** if temperature greater than 101 degrees develops lasting more than 24 hours or if there are any signs of **infection** (redness, drainage that is not clear, warmth at the incision sight).
- 10. If you are unable to reach a physician and immediate attention is needed, please go to the nearest emergency room.
