Dear Friends and Stakeholders:

As we reflect on 2024, we take pride in Health Services of North Texas' (HSNT) role in shaping healthier, stronger communities throughout Denton and Collin County. These vibrant regions continue to experience considerable growth, which brings unique opportunities that demand thoughtful solutions and partnerships. Your support has empowered HSNT to respond effectively and proactively to these evolving local needs.

Driven by our mission, our goals are clear: we meet patients where they are, providing them with the tools and resources necessary for a healthier, more resilient life. This past year alone, we welcomed an 8% increase in patients and saw a remarkable 12% rise in pediatric patients. With responsible stewardship at the heart of our approach, we are proud to report that 94 cents of every dollar received went directly toward patient care. Additionally, 95% of our patients reported that our sliding fee scale makes healthcare accessible and affordable.

Operational efficiency and effectiveness continue to be a strategic priority. In 2024, we implemented standing orders that streamlined workflows and allowed providers to focus on what they do best: attentive, quality patient care. We also restructured appointment schedules, enhancing convenience and improving patient access to medical care.

Further demonstrating our commitment to innovation and advancement, HSNT integrated new technology in 2024. Our Alpowered website chatbot, Al medical scribes, and enhanced patient communication have reduced administrative burdens, allowing our providers and staff more time to deliver highquality, personalized care.

Our commitment to excellence was nationally recognized this past August, as HSNT earned the Health Center Quality Leader badge at the silver level from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), placing us among the top tier of health centers nationwide. Additionally, we were honored with the Access Enhancer and Health Disparities Reducer badges, acknowledging our substantial progress in improving clinical measures and patient outcomes.

As Denton and Collin Counties continue to evolve, HSNT remains committed to staying ahead of the curve. For 2025, we have set ambitious goals, including achieving the Gold Level Health Center Quality Leader badge and expanding our reach to serve even more communities. Our culture of continuous improvement allows us to reduce barriers, innovate, and enhance the quality of care we provide.

Resilience at HSNT means preparing our communities to face whatever lies ahead. Through ongoing investment in innovation, infrastructure, and our team, we continually strengthen our ability to meet evolving needs and bridge the gaps to care. INFECTIOUS DISEASE





EXCEPTIONAL CLINICAL MEASURES



DIABETES MANAGEMENT (A1c CONTROL)

HSNT empowers patients to manage their A1c levels through continuous education, regular follow-ups, case management, and effective medication therapies. By working together, we help patients overcome barriers and achieve a controlled A1c.

73% of adult patients living with diabetes had an HbA1c level at or below 9

3% better than the national average!

BLOOD PRESSURE MANAGEMENT (HYPERTENSION CONTROL)

Improving hypertension rates can be challenging, but small lifestyle changes can make a big difference. Creating a calm, supportive environment and encouraging healthy habits helps our patients manage their blood pressure effectively.

DEPRESSION SCREENING (AGE 12+)

Early detection of depression symptoms makes a significant difference in the treatment and recovery of depression. HSNT routinely screens patients ages 12 and older using a proven Patient Health Questionnaire (PHQ) for depression symptoms.

STRATEGIC INITIATIVES

IN 2024, HEALTH SERVICES OF NORTH TEXAS DEMONSTRATED RESILIENCE AND CONTINUED INCREASING ACCESS TO CARE FOR MORE INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES.



INCREASED ACCESS TO APPOINTMENTS

By shifting providers' focus from rigid time slots to patient care blocks, HSNT improved capacity without compromising quality. In the 2024 patient experience survey, 94% of 2,028 respondents reported securing timely appointments, a 4% increase over two years.



INCREASED OUTREACH EVENTS

HSNT is focused on engaging with our community where they learn, live, play and work, especially in high need areas of our community. HSNT engaged with more than 4,400 potential patients across 31 outreach events throughout the year.



HSNT IMPLEMENTS ADVANCED MEDICAL SCRIBE AI

Adopting new technology into existing workflows takes intentional effort. HSNT's providers did just that in adopting a medical AI scribe to summarize their patient visits, improving provider engagement with patients, and increased accuracy and specificity in patient documentation. AI Scribe technology has proven to be a tremendous partner and resource for HSNT Providers across all service lines.



ADVOCACY CENTER OF EXCELLENCE GOLD AWARD PRESENTED BY NACHC

HSNT has earned the Gold Advocacy Center of Excellence (ACE) award from the National Association of Community Health Centers (NACHC). This is the highest recognition for health centers that make advocacy a priority. ACE health centers actively engage policymakers to secure support for affordable and innovative care. This designation highlights HSNT's commitment to telling the story of how community health centers impact patients, communities, and the local economy.

HSNT BEST creates a culture of problem solving that produces innovative operational excellence. This culture has paved the way for increased access to quality, affordable care by 14% over the past three years.

HSNT BEST is practiced in all areas of our business from creating a rubric to evaluate grant funding opportunities to implementing standing orders giving providers more time to do what only they can do in the patient care setting.





INCREASING ACCESS HRSA Quality Awards

HSNT'S ROLE AS A QUALITY LEADER IN COMMUNITY HEALTHCARE

In August 2024, HSNT was awarded a Silver Health Center Quality Leader badge by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) for our outstanding clinical quality performance in 2023, ranking in the top 11-20% of U.S. health centers. HSNT also received the Access Enhancer and Health Disparities Reducer badges for our significant improvements in patient access and health outcomes, including increased screenings for breast cancer, hypertension control, and HIV testing. With an 16% growth in total patients and a nearly 60% rise in enabling services between 2022 and 2024, HSNT continues to expand our impact in North Texas.



BREAKING DOWN BARRIERS A Collaboration Dedicated to Healing

WORKING TOGETHER TO PROVIDE HEALTHCARE FOR THOSE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS

According to United Way of Denton County, there are 627 households experiencing homelessness in Denton County as of October 2024. HSNT partners with Our Daily Bread (ODB) to provide essential medical care to those experiencing homelessness in Denton, Texas through traumacompassionate, informed, and accessible services. Many individuals experiencing homelessness struggle with chronic illnesses, disabilities, and stigma associated with their living conditions, but HSNT ensures they receive respectful and judgment-free care. Through a sliding-fee scale and proximity to the ODB shelter, HSNT makes healthcare attainable for those in need, offering same-day appointments when possible. Ultimately, HSNT's commitment to meeting patients where they are fosters trust, improves health outcomes, and strengthens the community's support network for those experiencing homelessness.



BUILDING CAPACITY

Impact of Standing Orders

MAXIMIZING EFFICIENCY WITH STANDING ORDERS AT EACH HSNT HEALTH CENTER

In 2024, our standing orders played an important role in streamlining care and lightening provider workload across our six health centers. By enabling our medical team to act proactively, we enhanced efficiency and access to care in impactful ways:

- 57,000+ calls answered by our Medical Office team, maintaining a 98% answer rate.
- Over 1,000 new patient intakes completed with a 97% success rate in Family Practice, improving new patient onboarding.
- 16,000+ point-of-care tests conducted without requiring a provider-prompted order, expediting diagnostics and treatment decisions for patients.

These standing orders and protocols help our providers focus on delivering high-quality, patient-centered care.



Introducing the EQN Team

HSNT ELIGIBILITY QUALITY NAVIGATORS ARE HELPING BRIDGE THE GAP

The Eligibility Quality Navigator Team is supporting patient care at HSNT with timely screenings, follow-ups, and access to resources. In 2024, they:

- Managed 258 Transition of Care Notices, helping facilitate smooth follow-ups for hospital discharges and ER visits.
- Facilitated 463 Mobile Mammograms, surpassing national screening rates.
- Contacted 600+ patients for colorectal screenings, leading to 82 completed tests and 13 early detections.
- Scheduled 1,266 appointments for preventive care, chronic disease management, and screenings.
- Assisted 53 patients with Medicaid & Medicare enrollments, improving access to care.

Through their dedication, the EQNs removed barriers, closed care gaps, and made a lasting impact on community health in 2024.


