*The focus of our research program was to examine microvascular responses to acute and chronic hypoxia. We have previously seen that hypoxia results in rapid increases in leukocyte-endothelial adhesive interactions and increased vascular permeability in various organs. The mechanism of this response involves generation of reactive oxidants, which could potentially promote injury by inactivation of nitric oxide. We have recently developed a method using a fluorescent probe (DAF-2) to measure nitric oxide levels during hypoxia in vivo. This particular project should add to our understanding of microvascular responses to hypoxia.*
