



## Hormone Replacement Fee Acknowledgement

Therapellet hormone replacement is safe and effective, but still not recognized by insurance companies as “alternative” medicine. Despite your treatment being overseen by our Board Certified Physcian, Physician Assistant, and/or Nurse Practitioner, insurance does not recognize it as necessary medicine, and thus not covered by most insurance companies. You are obligated to pay for our services (blood work, consultations, or insertions) at the time of service. If you choose, we will provide a form to send to your insurance company and a receipt showing that you paid out of pocket. We will not communicate in any way with your insurance company.

\*Consult fees are not applied to pellet insertion, if at your consult you also receive pellet insertion there will be a charge for the consult and pellet insertion. The consult fee is a one time fee to establish you with our practice and a medical practitioner.

\*\*Labwork is required pre-consult to determine if you are a candidate for pellets, if you are a candidate you will have to get another set of labs done post pellet insertion and there will be an additional charge for post labs (males at 4 weeks post insertion and women at 6 weeks post insertion).

\*\*\*Hormone pellets will need to be inserted multiple times a year and there is a fee for each insertion.
