

15 ★ Lunch & Learn: Healthy Activities at Tennessee State Parks

 The State Museum, in partnership with Cumberland River Compact and Tennessee State Parks, hosts a free presentation with Park Ranger Hobart Aiken. From the earliest cries for the development of public parks, thinking about the health and wellbeing of the public was crucial. 16 & 17 ★ Celebrating Tennessee Woman Suffrage

10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
 Tennessee figured prominently in the quest for Woman Suffrage, which led to American women obtaining the right to vote. Join the Museum, Tennessee State Parks and Tennessee State Library & Archives for two full days of free activities in commemoration of the ratification of the 19th Amendment. The events will occur at Bicentennial

Capitol Mall State Park and Tennessee State Museum. There will be living history presentations on prominent women in the Suffrage movement and fun activities about the ways Suffragists advocated for the vote. Finally, there will be a 5K commemorating the "Run to Ratification."
